Vicky is currently employed as Hauora Whakahaere and Researcher for Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Kuia; Covid Response coordinator for Te Tauihi iwi; Covid Co-chair on Process Review Clinical pathway rōpū; Ngāti Kuia representative on Whakatū Arts Culture and Heritage, Te Ohu Toi Ahurea; Advisor and mentor to AVA Business Solutions – whānau Māori business startup.

Vicky's prior roles have included Operations and Gallery curator for Kahurangi Employment Trust; Manager Whakatū Service Centre, Ministry of Social Development; and she has worked for NZ Employment Service and Inland Revenue.

Vicky identifies the significant procurement of a Health Research Council (HRC) Kanohi ki te Kanohi grant for Māori community groups to undertake health research to address community-identified health needs research in a pūrākau methodology of cultural narratives for the wellbeing of iwi hauora.
