The Sports Funding Allocation Terms and Conditions:

- 1. Applications will be considered for Ngati Toa Individuals who have been selected to represent their sport at a National and/or International competition.
- 2. Projects that are not eligible include;
 - Commercial venture
 - Capital fund or debt reduction
 - Completed projects and events/projects already paid
- 3. Funding levels per person are set by the sports committee and vary depending on funding allocated by Te Rūnanga O Toa Rangatira Inc each year and the number of applicants each year.
- 4. All relevant items on the checklist at the beginning of the application must be completed before application can begin to be processed.
- 5. Individuals can anticipate national selection and funds are held over until selection is confirmed. We recognise that the timing of representation does not always fit with our funding criteria.

Application Process:

Completed applications must be received at least one month before the event starts.

Once the grant is completed with all supporting documents, the applications are emailed to the sports committee for approval. Timing of approval depends on the availability of the committee members.

Payment and remittance advice will be sent to the Applicants Representative Club, Association, Regional or National. Grants are paid on the 20th of the month (or the next business day following the 20th).

Also due to the high volume of applications for NZ Maori Basketball National Tournament and Waka Ama National Sprint Championships a special deadline of 30th November 2018 for all completed sports grant applications for these two events is also in place.
